Michelyn Wright received her Honours Bachelor of Music Education, an Artist's Performance Diploma from the University of Western Ontario, and then her Master of Music in Voice Performance at the Mannes College of Music in New York City. Through these years she studied with such great teachers as Bernard Diamant, Lois Marshall, Dr. Darryl Edwards and Ruth Falcon. In 1997 she worked with Joan Sutherland and Richard Bonyngé at the Britten Pears School.

Michelyn has performed as a soloist with the Guelph Chamber Choir, the Kitchener Waterloo Symphony Orchestra, Toronto Operetta Theatre, and was a chorister with the Canadian Opera Company Chorus from 1998-2008.

Michelyn has been an active voice teacher in Markham since 1997. She became a member of the National Association of Teachers of Singing in 1999 and is the President of the Markham Stouffville ORMTA Branch. Michelyn has been an Artist Educator with the Canadian Opera Company Education Department, Vocal Music Director for the Unionville Theatre Company and a Vocal Instructor for the Bach Children's Chorus.

Currently, Michelyn has a large private voice studio and is a Sessional Lecturer at the University of Toronto, teaching Voice Education to undergraduate instrumental music students. This past summer of 2025 she was the Chair of the Volunteer Committee for the International Congress of Voice Teachers. Michelyn thrives on working with singers of all ages and experiences.
